River Valley Mountain Bike Association: Drew Smithburger, provided an update. The association has built 10 miles of trails on the Rudolph property on Millgate. Approximately \$3,000 is needed for hauling fill dirt by dump truck. Also the group needs a heavy duty walk behind brush cutter which costs approximately \$3,000. MRCC had the first of two votes to donate \$1,000 to this association.
